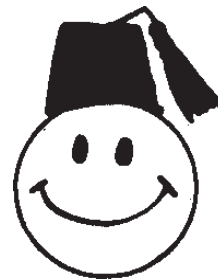

When you attend Asiya Shrine Center events, you will notice a cabinet in the alcove between the Dining Room and Meeting room. This cabinet displays a sampling of the items our Hospital Sewing group makes to meet the requests of the Northern California and Honolulu Shriners Hospitals for Children. Hospital Sewing meets at the Asiya Shrine Center on the third Wednesday of each month except June and July. We have a loyal group of 15 to 20 ladies attending each month, but we always welcome new members. There are many opportunities to help even if you don't sew, and we always enjoy the camaraderie while we work and later enjoy the salads and desserts prepared by our hostesses of the month at our lunch meeting.

We also raise money and accept donations of supplies and items to assist the patients in our Shrine Hospitals. Last September we held a Salad Bar fund raiser at the Shrine Center where Shriners and friends were invited to attend and see examples of the work we do. We are very grateful for the \$1600 raised by those who attended or sent in donations to this project. This will keep us in good supply of essential sewing notions and other items needed to meet Hospital requests for the time being.
